TRANSPORTATION DIRECTIONS

- All groups must arrange their own transportation to and from all *Disney Grad Nite* events.
- All vehicles must be driven by a bus driver or chaperone. *Student driven vehicles are not permitted.*
- It is recommended that event tickets be distributed to each student or responsible chaperone before leaving your school, in the event you become separated.
- **Make sure everyone in your group is aware of where your transportation will be parked at the end of the event. This location will be given to you upon arrival.**

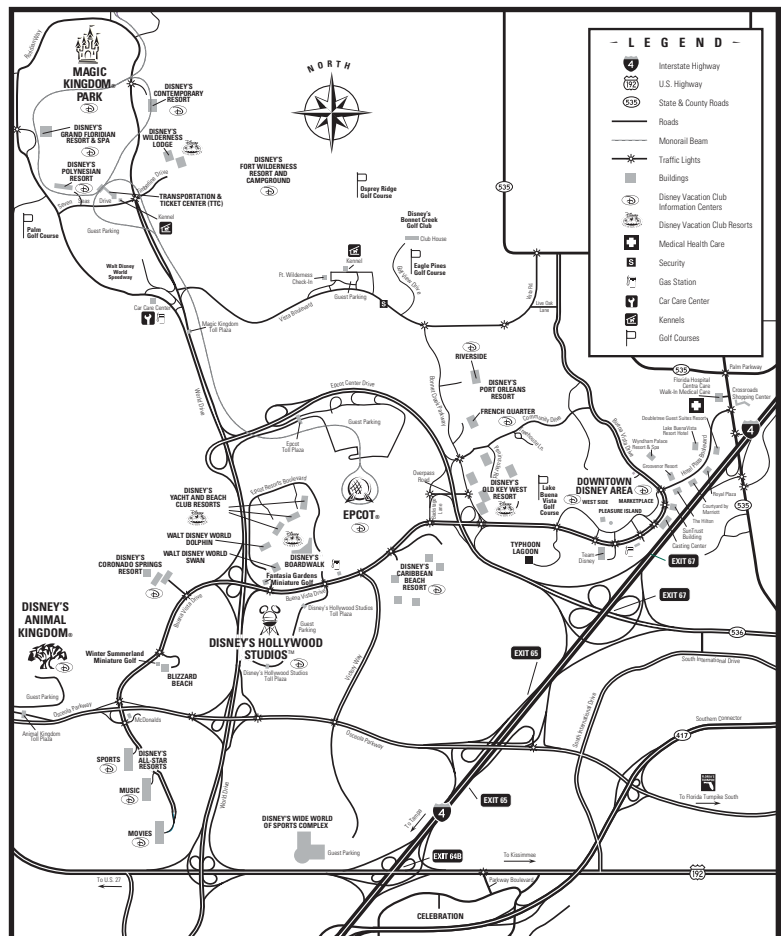
WALT DISNEY WORLD® RESORT

The *Walt Disney World* Resort is located 16 miles southeast of downtown Orlando, off Interstate 4, west of the Florida Turnpike.

- **From southbound Interstate 75**, take the Florida Turnpike south, to Interstate 4 west.
- **From International Drive or Interstate 95**, take Interstate 4 west.
- **From northbound on the Florida Turnpike**, exit west at the Osceola Parkway.
- **From the Orlando International Airport**, take toll road 417 via the airport's South Exit (417S) to Osceola Parkway west (Exit 3).
- **From I-75 Southbound or Florida's Turnpike Southbound via SR - 429**, take exit #267A/APOPKA (CR-535) onto SR-429 (Toll applies) - go 14.7 mi Take exit #8/DISNEY WORLD/HARTZOG RD onto WESTERN WAY toward DISNEY WORLD - Follow signs to the *EPCOT*® Park. *EPCOT*® will then dispatch your bus to *Disney's Hollywood Studios*™.

DISNEY GRAD NITE / DISNEY'S HOLLYWOOD STUDIOS™

- Once you arrive on *Walt Disney World*® Resort property, follow signs to *EPCOT*®. *EPCOT*® will then dispatch your bus to *Disney's Hollywood Studios*™.
- As you approach the *EPCOT*® Auto Plaza, signs will direct *Disney Grad Nite* buses through a designated lane.
- A Disney Host/Hostess will direct you to the appropriate drop-off area. Once your buses have checked in, they will be directed to their designated drop-off location at *Disney's Hollywood Studios*™.
- Please note: This location is different from previous years. Please follow the signs.
- **Please do not arrive more than 1/2 hour before the start of the main event at *Disney's Hollywood Studios*™.**



EVENT ENTRY

All students and chaperones are required to have a *Disney Grad Nite* event ticket to be admitted to *Disney's Hollywood Studios*™. A Will Call Table will be set up at each entrance for any last minute add-ons.

ALL schools should conduct their own Security and Dress Code screening prior to departing for *Disney Grad Nite*.

Chaperones should stay with their groups through the entire entry process at each *Disney Grad Nite* event.

Each student will need to place all articles from their pockets into a provided plastic bag. Each student and chaperone will undergo a "friendly frisk" prior to entering all events to check for cigarettes, alcohol, illegal substances, weapons, and other prohibited items.

- The frisk may include opening up a jacket, lifting pant legs over shoes, cleaning out pockets and emptying any containers.
 - All unauthorized items will be confiscated by *Walt Disney World*® Security.
 - Any prescription or over-the counter medication must be listed on the enclosed Medical Situation / Special Needs form. A copy of this form must be kept with the individual requiring the medication and on file at First Aid.

All guest bags (camera cases, purses, etc.) will be searched prior to entering any *Disney Grad Nite* event. IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT GUESTS REFRAIN FROM BRINGING IN ANY UNNECESSARY BAGS.

Ticket Media will be delivered to you prior to your arrival. It is your responsibility to make sure you have the right number of tickets for your group. All students and chaperones must have the correct ticket media to gain admission to any *Disney Grad Nite* event.

The following is required for admission to the listed events:

- **DISNEY GRAD NITE / DISNEY'S HOLLYWOOD STUDIOS**™ - (1) ONE EVENT TICKET per student and chaperone



DRIVER INFORMATION

Please provide this information to your drivers.

Drivers are responsible for keeping all students and chaperones on the bus/van until a Disney Parking Host/Hostess gives permission to disembark.

After dropping off students at the *Disney Grad Nite* event, Disney Parking Hosts/Hostesses will direct drivers to a specified parking location in the parking lot. Drivers are not required to stay in the parking lot during the events. Remember to confirm a pick-up time with your driver.

Drivers also acting as chaperones, must have a Chaperone ticket, follow the Dress Code, and adhere to all other guidelines.
Driver will be separated from group while parking transport.

DRIVER LOUNGE AT *DISNEY'S HOLLYWOOD STUDIOS*TM

- Drivers not acting as Chaperones will be able to relax in a Lounge located at the Fantasia Gardens Pavilion.
- Food and Beverages available for purchase.
- Disney Parking Hosts/Hostesses will direct drivers to the shuttle to the lounge area.



CHAPERONE INSTRUCTIONS

Dear Chaperone,

We're working hard to make this year's *Disney Grad Nite* celebration special for the class of 2009.

As a chaperone, you are an integral part of the magic. We're making some changes to the event to make sure that our grads have the time of their lives.

Here's how you can help make that happen:

Prepare for the Magic - Prior to Arrival

- Make sure students are adhering to the appropriate attire guidelines, and are not carrying inappropriate items (cigarettes, weapons etc.).
- Confirm that all students attending the event are attendees at your school, and are at least 16 years old.
- Have a plan for you and the other chaperones to contact each other if needed.

Protect the Magic - Upon Arrival

- Advise students they will be going through a friendly frisk and security check upon entry. Anything deemed inappropriate will be confiscated and may not be returned. Any illegal substances or items will be dealt with by the appropriate authorities.

Enjoy the Magic - At the Event

We know that adult visibility helps make this event more enjoyable for everyone attending. Allow us to partner with you as you engage chaperones from your school, and share the new information for 2009.

We will be providing Chaperone Credentials to your school, and will request that you and the other chaperones wear them. The credentials will allow you the following:

- Priority entry to some of the most popular attractions
- Access to the chaperone breakfast and lounge
- The Magic of Disney Animation attraction will be the lounge for those chaperones on duty. Each school will need to check in here and we recommend one representative remain here throughout the night.

The credentials will also have information and tips for chaperones at the event, including a new Chaperone Hotline phone number for you to contact if you need assistance from our Security team inside the Park.

Chaperones are encouraged to go out and visit the different areas of the park, and to be visible to the students during this special event. Your participation will help ensure a great event for all.

CHAPERONE INFORMATION

All Chaperones Must be at Least 21 Years Old.

THINGS EVERY CHAPERONE SHOULD KNOW

Chaperone Credentials: Chaperones must keep their *Disney Grad Nite* Ticket (marked "Chaperone" on back) with them for the entire event and they will be provided official Chaperone credentials for the event.

Complimentary Chaperone Breakfast: A complimentary breakfast will be provided for Chaperones during the event. Please see your Chaperone Credentials for breakfast times.

Chaperone Smoking Policy: Due to our no-smoking policy throughout the *Walt Disney World*® Resort, the only Chaperone smoking areas will be an outdoor area located near Chaperone Headquarters.

Chaperone Hotline: A hotline number (located on your credential) will be provided in case you need to contact *Walt Disney World*® Security.

Attraction Access: Your credential will also give you "front of the line" access to some of the most popular *Disney's Hollywood Studios*™ attractions. Please show your credential to the Cast Member at the front of the attraction for this access.

CHAPERONE PAGERS/CELL PHONES

- Please make sure the Head Chaperone is the first to enter *Disney's Hollywood Studios*™ so that he/she can go directly to Chaperone Headquarters.
 - The pager pick up location is at The Magic of Disney Animation attraction beginning at 8:00 PM. We recommend at least one person remains at Animation.
 - **When you pick up your pager, you will be required to leave your driver's license or school ID card as a deposit.**
 - Additional pagers will not be available unless a special request is made. Please email our office at Traci.M.Kennedy@disney.com.
 - Pagers must be returned to The Magic of Disney Animation attraction beginning at 1:00 AM. Any pagers not returned or damaged will result in a \$70.00 per pager charge.
 - If there are any situations where a student, Chaperone, or Disney representative would need to reach you, you will be paged.
 - Chaperones may also provide their cell phone numbers as preferred communication instead of pagers. If you would like to provide this in advance, please email Traci.M.Kennedy@disney.com.

STUDENT GUIDELINES

Students attending *Disney Grad Nite* have a responsibility to:

- Treat others with respect and honesty
- Remain in approved attire throughout the *Disney Grad Nite* events (see Dress Code section)
- Conduct themselves in a manner which will not interfere with other guests
- Report any hazardous or dangerous situation to an adult or *Disney Cast Member*

Students must not:

- Possess or distribute any material prohibited, such as drugs, drug paraphernalia, alcohol, weapons, or any gang-related item
- Fight or engage in horseplay
- Harass others for any reason
- Chant school names

SUGGESTED GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOLS

Students who have been recommended for expulsion or who have had serious disciplinary action will not be considered "students in good standing," therefore should not be permitted to participate in *Disney Grad Nite*.

**Please note: Failure to follow the guidelines may result in delayed admission and/or denial of admission to your Disney Grad Nite event. Also, Walt Disney World® Cast Members have the right to refuse admission to anyone they deem not appropriately dressed for the event and not following these guidelines. The dress code for Disney Grad Nite will be enforced throughout the event by all Disney Cast Members working the event. Note: Some schools may enforce a stricter dress code.*



"DRESS TO PARTY" GUIDELINES

Disney Grad Nite is **no ordinary day in the park**. Everyone attending this hot party will be dressed to impress. This all-night party is a big deal for everyone and you gotta look good if you're going to have fun.

THESE STYLES ARE A HIT!

FOR THE LADIES

- Dresses
- Skirts
- Shorts
- Casual pants (including khaki-style or jeans)
- Dress blouse or top
- Comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress sandals, or boots)

FOR THE GUYS

- Casual or dress pants (including khaki-style or jeans)
- Shorts are also acceptable for guys
- Shirt with collar (i.e., golf-style shirt, dress shirt)
- Sport jacket
- Suit
- Comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress shoes, or boots)

THESE STYLES ARE A MISS!

FOR THE LADIES

- Halter and similar-style tops
- Tops that show the midriff
- Mini skirts or mini dresses

FOR THE GUYS

- Tank-tops
- Sleeveless t-shirts
- Undershirts

THESE STYLES ARE NOT A HIT FOR ANYONE!

- Any clothing affiliated with a school, professional sports team, group, club, etc. (Chaperones and faculty members will be permitted to wear school affiliated golf shirts or polos).
- Clothing not in good repair (torn jeans, pants, shirts, etc.) Jeans are okay as long as they are not ripped or torn.
- Revealing clothing (i.e. bathing suit tops or bottoms, cropped tops, see-through clothing, etc)
- Hats, Bandanas Doo-rags and/or Towels (Either worn or hanging from belt loops/pockets, etc.)
- Any article of clothing with an area code on it
- Chains or spiked accessories
- Oversized belts and necklaces
- All backpacks. (Small purses and hip bags are okay.)
- Weapons, knives, laser pointers or chemical irritants are not permitted. Students or chaperones not following this guideline will be dealt with at the discretion of the Orange County Sheriff's Office.
- Alcohol, tobacco products and controlled substances are not allowed and will be confiscated and not returned if found onsite.



EVENT DEPARTURE

No one can leave the events prior to the printed departure times unless you submit a request using the enclosed Transportation Information form.

DISNEY GRAD NITE EVENT DEPARTURE

- **Groups will not be allowed to leave *Disney's Hollywood Studios*™ until one hour prior to the end of the event, unless a special request has been submitted prior to arrival.**
- All attendees must exit through the front gate turnstiles.
- Please designate 2 chaperones to be Parking Lot Duty Chaperones. These individuals must exit to the parking lot prior to 12:30 AM.
 - Chaperones may exit at a designated turnstile at the front entrance to head to the buses by showing their Chaperone credential.
 - Once in the parking lot, it is the responsibility of the Parking Lot Duty Chaperones to locate their buses and help coordinate the boarding of their students.
 - All other Chaperones will exit through the front gate turnstiles at the conclusion of the event.
- To get to the *Disney's Hollywood Studios*™ parking lot, guests can exit through the front gate turnstiles and walk to where their vehicles are parked.
- Disney Hosts/Hostesses will be stationed throughout the exit route to answer questions and direct attendees to the correct locations.
- If any students are missing once your group boards the bus, a Chaperone should contact a Disney Security Host/Hostess in the Parking Lot.
