<b>College Visit</b>	Visit the college so you know what the campus is like.	You can excuse 4 days of school. You must bring signed documentation of your formal visit to Mrs. Mills.	
<b>College Essay</b>	Find out the Essay topics for your college applications	Write your essay early so you can get help from your English teacher. Your essay could possibly determine whether you are accepted or not!	
<b>Applications</b>	Check deadlines & Apply during the fall!	Go to your college website to apply online or fill out a common application at <a href="http://www.commonapp.org">www.commonapp.org</a>	
<b>Letter of Recommendation</b>	Find out if you need recommendations for your colleges.	If you need a letter, submit a <b>Recommendation Request</b> to your counselor and allow at least <b>3 weeks</b>	
<b>Transcript</b>	Go to Ms. Smith to have an official transcript sent to your college.	Colleges will not accept a copy of your transcript! Fill out a request with Mrs. Smith. <u>It will cost \$1 for colleges out of state, private colleges and SPC.</u> Free for colleges in state.	
<b>Scholarships Deadline→</b>	Sign up for as many as you can  <b>Deadline→ Deadline→ Deadline→</b>	Go to Pinellas County's Financial Aid Website to sign up: <a href="http://www.pinellas.k12.fl.us/finaid">www.pinellas.k12.fl.us/finaid</a> <a href="http://www.pinellaseducation.org">www.pinellaseducation.org</a> by December <a href="http://www.fastweb.com">www.fastweb.com</a>	
<b>Bright Futures</b>	Register after December 1 <sup>st</sup> FAFSA is required for all bright futures scholarships.	You must register at <a href="http://www.floridastudentfinancialaid.org">www.floridastudentfinancialaid.org</a> or you're not eligible. You have until the end of the year to qualify.	
<b>Financial Aid Deadline→</b>	All Seniors <b>MUST</b> complete the FAFSA at <a href="http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/">http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/</a> in January. <b>Deadline is May.</b> Read through your Financial Aid Folder for instructions.	You may qualify for grants and/or loans to help cover tuition. The earlier you sign up, the better your chances are at getting financial aid in time to start college.
