WHAT'S IN

Girls— Dresses, skirts, shorts, casual pants (including jeans), blouses and tops, and comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress sandals, and boots).

Guys— Casual pants (including khaki style, shorts and jeans), shirts with collar (golf style shirts, dress shirts), sport jackets, dress suits, comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, sandals, dress shoes, and boots).

WHAT'S OUT

- 1) Any clothing affiliated with a school, professional sports team, group, club, etc.
- 2) Clothing not in good repair (torn jeans, pants, shirts, etc.) Jeans are okay as long as they are not ripped or torn.
- 3) Revealing clothing (i.e. bathing suit tops or bottoms, cropped tops, see-through clothing, etc)
- 4) Hats and/or Bandanas (Either worn or hanging from belt loops/pockets, etc.)
- 5) All backpacks. Small purses and hip bags are okay.
- 6) Weapons, knives, laser pointers or chemical irritants are not permitted. Students or chaperones not following this guideline will be dealt with at the discretion of the Orange County Sheriff's Office.
- 7) Alcohol and tobacco products are not allowed and will be confiscated and not returned if found onsite.

Please note: Failure to follow the guidelines may result in delayed admission and/or denial of admission to your Disney Grad Nite event. Also, Walt Disney World Cast Members have the right to refuse admission to anyone they deem not appropriately dressed for the event and not following these guidelines. The dress code for Disney Grad Nite will be enforced throughout the event by all Cast Members working the event. Note: Some schools may enforce a stricter dress code.

The dress code list is for descriptive purposes and is not all-inclusive; other attire which does not conform to the standards set forth above will be deemed inappropriate. Students not properly dressed, as set forth above, will be refused admittance and will be denied a refund of any kind. If you are unsure whether or not something is acceptable, don't wear it!
